



**EXTERIOR WARRANTY**  
**PRECOATED SIGNATURE™ 200 Panel**

Limited Warranty

Pala Technologies, Inc. dba Elite Buildings warrants the panels, effective from the date of shipment, will perform in accordance to the following Signature™ 200 Warranty:

**PERFORMANCE SUMMARY**

**FILM INTEGRITY:** The paint film WILL NOT crack, check, blister, peel, flake or chip for a period of twenty (20) years for Sidewall and Roof panels. Cracking is defined as breaks in the flat coating as opposed to breaks in the film caused by metal forming, which is not warranted hereunder.

## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**


### **FAILED MATERIAL –**

If the panel finish fails to perform as indicated under the terms of Performance outlined above, Pala shall have no liability with respect thereto except, at its sole option to repaint, replace, or restore the failed material, which shall be the purchaser's sole and exclusive remedy. Repainting shall not necessarily be Signature 200. In no event, however, shall Pala Technologies, Inc's responsibility extend to any consequential damages and in all cases Pala Technologies, Inc reserves the right to approve and negotiate the contract for such repainting, replacing or restoring. The warranty on any repainted, replaced or restored coated material supplied hereunder shall be for the unexpired portion of the warranty period applicable to the original panel.

## CLAIMS


Claims must be reported in writing to Pala Technologies, Inc within thirty (30) days after discovery of nonconformance, rupturing, perforating or structurally failing sheet or for any special, indirect, or consequential loss of profits or any other incidental, general special or comensatory damages to anyone by reason of the fact that such panels shall have been nonconforming, rupturing, perforating, or structurally failing. Adequate identification of the material involved in the claim, including date of installation, Pala Technologies, Inc's order number, invoice number, and date of shipment must be established by Buyer. A copy of this document must be presented to Pala Technologies, Inc at time of claim. All notices given under or pursuant tot his Agreement shall be in writing and sent by registered mail, postage prepaid, return receipt requested to:

This warranty covers the material exposed to normal atmospheric conditions (which term excludes corrosive or aggressive atmospheres such as, but not limited to, those contaminated with chemical fumes or direct salt spray) in the continental United States or Canada, unless Pala Technologies, Inc agrees other wise in writing. This warranty shall not apply where material failure is the result of fire, other accident or casualty, vandalism, salt spray, atomic radiation, harmful fumes or foreign substances in the atmosphere, acts of God, or other such occurrences beyond Pala Technologies, Inc's control. This warranty will not extend to or cover damages to the material due to improper packaging, shipping or processing as specified in the national Coil Coaters Association Technical Bulletin No. IV(7), improper handling (whether pre-erection or during erections), improper storage, improper erection, or improper installation (which includes failure to permit drainage or standing water.)

Microscopic crazing of the film on outside radii is considered normal and is not to be construed as film cracking. This warranty does not apply in the event of deterioration to the panels caused directly or indirectly by panel contact with inferior fasteners. Selection of suitable long-lasting fasteners to be used with Pala Technologies, Inc extended life panels rests solely with the Purchaser.



This warranty will not extend to or cover:

Damage to the coating occasioned by moisture or other contaminations detrimental to the coating.

Water damage to any materials after they leave the possession of Pala Technologies, Inc.

Damage to the pre-painted metal caused by shipping, handling, and/or installation, storing, erecting and /or handling of panels on the job side and/or any act or acts of negligence of the customer or any third party after the panels leave the possession of Pala Technologies, Inc.

Customer shall exercise diligence in inspection of materials as received from Pala Technologies, Inc prior to use so as to mitigate expense involved to Pala Technologies, Inc under this warranty.

This warranty does not apply to the interior or reverse side finish nor does it extend to pre-painted materials used in interior (not atmospherically exposed) applications.

Panels repainted, replaced or otherwise restored under this warranty shall not extend the original warranty expiration date as applicable hereunder.

This warranty applies only to the paint film on the material and does not cover in any way any other aspect of the material.

**ASSIGNMENT** - This warranty shall extend to the purchaser of the material and is non-assignable and/or non-transferable. Should the Purchaser become insolvent, bankrupt, make an assignment for the benefit of its creditors, or for any reason discontinue its normal or regular business practices, this warranty shall forthwith become null and void and of no legal effect.

**EXCEPT AS SET FORTH HEREIN, PALA TECHNOLOGIES, INC MAKE NO OTHER WARRANTIES, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, LIMITED OR OTHERWISE, INCLUDING ANY IMPLIED WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, WITH RESPECT TO THE MATERIAL.** In no way shall Pala Technologies, Inc be responsible for any loss of profit or any other incidental, general, special, compensatory or consequential damages resulting from the failure of the material covered by this warranty.

The laws of the State of Texas shall govern the rights and duties of the parties under this agreement and jurisdiction and venue is fixed in Grayson County, Texas. This warranty is the full and complete agreement of the parties and shall not be modified, altered or extended except in writing signed by the President of Pala Technologies, Inc.
